

**FRUITLAND PARK SPECIAL CITY COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES**  
**April 30, 2013**

MEETING STATISTICS. A special meeting of the Fruitland Park City Commission was conducted in the Commission Chambers of City Hall, 506 West Berckman Street, Fruitland Park, Florida on Tuesday, April 30, 2013 beginning at 7:00 p.m.

INVOCATION AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE. Commissioner Gunter delivered the invocation followed by the Pledge of Allegiance led by Commissioner Cheshire.

ROLL CALL. Mayor Bell asked City Clerk Diane Gibson Smith to call the roll.

ELECTED OFFICIALS PRESENT. Commissioner Albert O. Goldberg, Commissioner Christopher Cheshire, Commissioner John L. Gunter, Jr., Vice Mayor Sharon Kelly, and Mayor Christopher J. Bell.

MUNICIPAL OFFICIALS/OTHERS PRESENT. Acting City Manager (ACM)/Police Chief (PC) Terry Isaacs, City Clerk (CC) Diane Gibson Smith, Community Development Director (CDD) Charlie Rector

01. Interviewed Mr. Peter Brill for position of City Treasurer and offered him the position.

Mayor Bell introduced Mr. Brill and requested he give some background on himself.

The Commissioners were then given a chance to ask questions of Mr. Brill. Mr. Brill provided answers to all questions asked.

Mayor Bell requested Mr. Brill to leave the room for final discussions among the Commission. The Commission agreed to offer the position to Mr. Brill at \$57,000 with re-evaluation in 90 days. Moving expenses could be used for negotiations.

Vice Mayor Kelly suggested we could perhaps evolve the position to an Assistant City Manager/City Treasurer in the future. The Commission was in agreement to perhaps offer in the future.

Mayor Bell offered the position to Mr. Brill at a starting salary of \$57,000. Mr. Brill stated he is currently around \$20,000 over that.

Vice Mayor Kelly reviewed the benefits offered by the City. Mr. Brill took a copy of the benefits offered.

Mayor Bell stated we are also talking about the Assistant City Manager idea but it is a thought in the future. He suggested Mr. Brill put together some ideas about the position and get back to us with his thoughts.

Mayor Bell suggested we look at what Groveland is asking to offer.
